- The Assessor presented the Proof of Publication Notice for the 2012-2013 FY Amended Budget published in the Quad City Times and the North Scott Press, June 27, 2012.

- A motion was made to open the public hearing on the amending of the FY 2012-2013 budget, as required by HF 524 by Cusack and second by Johanson at 9:21 a.m. Having received no correspondence and with no public in attendance the public hearing was closed at 9:22 a.m. on a motion by Cusack and second by Weibel.
