Subj: Vehicle bids for the Sheriff's Office - MEG

As you may recall, the Sheriff's Office participates in the Quad City Metropolitan Enforcement Group (MEG). The Sheriff plans to reassign one deputy position from patrol to MEG. That will necessitate an additional unmarked vehicle for that deputy and will reduce the number of marked squad cars in service, likewise by one.

The bids we received for a class 3 four door mid-sized vehicle are as follows:
