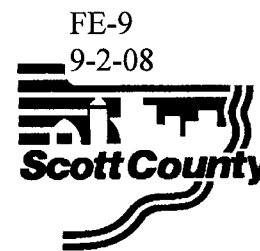

Subj: Changes to the County Parking Ordinance diagram

As you may recall, the designation of parking types on the county campus is referred within the ordinance to a diagram certified by the Board and kept on file in the County Administrator's Office. Typically, that same diagram has been posted in several locations to allow visitor's and staff to use the diagram as a legend of parking designations.

With construction on our campus coming to an end, I wanted to update the diagram and also re-examine parking designations throughout the campus. Since the Board last discussed parking on the campus, the impact of the jail construction has eased and we have also added the lot at 5th and Ripley Streets. I have attached a copy of the proposed revised parking diagram for your reference. On the diagram, we have inserted parking space counts in the various lots as well as totals for the various categories of parking.

As the diagram indicates, the proposed total space counts, if the Board adopts the revised plan, will include:

- 232 Visitor spaces
- 277 Employee spaces
- 38 Handicapped assessable spaces

In addition, there are at least 70 on-street spaces that our employees regularly use. Those spaces are primarily on Western and 5th Streets.

The changes to the diagram would take effect immediately upon the Board adopting the diagram via resolution. FSS plans to utilize e-mail and flyers to inform employees of the changes. Beyond that, we would issue warning reminders to encourage compliance, using ticketing only as a last resort. We don't expect non-compliance to be a widespread issue. I will be at the next Committee of the Whole meeting to discuss my recommendations further with you and the Board. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
