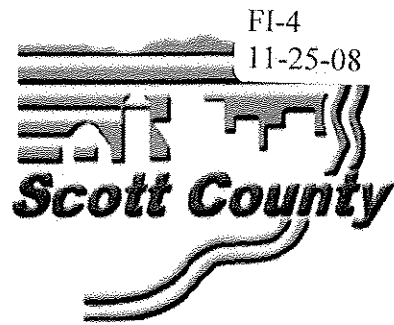

Subject: Sheriff's Office Dispatch radio console PC and application upgrade.

A quote has been received from RACOM to upgrade the PC's and application used in Sheriff's Dispatch to control and access the RACOM radio equipment for Sheriff's Office 800 MHz trunked radio system communications. This radio systems is critical to Sheriff's Office operations.

These upgrades will continue to be used by Scott Emergency Communications Center as part of the backup dispatch operation and should be considered critical both now and in the future.

This application upgrade project will replace PC's that are over five years old and are currently running the Windows 2000 operating system.

The City of Davenport Dispatch operation co-located in the Court House is currently utilizing this upgraded application.

It is recommended that the Board approve the bid from RACOM in the amount of \$16,350.00. Budget dollars are available in the Electronic Equipment Capital Plan to fund the cost of project.
