Subj: Requested Contract Amendment with CADS FY'09 Contract

Attached, please find a request from CADS regarding additional expenses that they have incurred for the case management program provided to inmates in the Scott County jail. Based on discussion with county staff it is recommended that Scott County's FY'09 contract with CADS be amended to allow for Case Management Services in the jail to increase from \$68,000 to \$86,683.00. In allowing for that increase county dollars allotted for Treatment of Substance Abuse Dependency Problems for Inmates of Scott County Jail would be reduced from \$130,000 to \$111,317.00.


Included in this letter is a revised outline of the funding request for our case management program. The additional expense we have had to reconsider is directly related to increased employee benefit costs projected for the remainder of the fiscal year.

Through nine (9) months of Fiscal Year 2009, our year to date expenses for our case management program for Scott County is \$64,216.40. Our annual contract amount with Scott County is \$68,000.00. I estimate that our costs for the remaining three (3) months of this fiscal year will be \$22,466.00. Based on this, we will spend \$18,682.40 more than our contract amount.

I am requesting that we be allowed to bill the remaining funds from the Inmate Substance Abuse Treatment Funds we discussed with you and Dee Bruemmer, Scott County Administrator on 4/14/09 as we will not be drawing down all of those funds.
