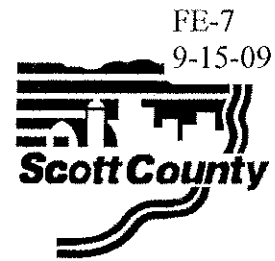

RE: Bike Trail between Eldridge and Long Grove

The Board of Supervisors has supported the planning, design and construction of the Eldridge and Long Grove bike path for several years. Funding for the design was recently obtained through the ARRA transportation funds to the region. Bi-State Regional Commission on behalf of the two cities has submitted grants to the IDOT for the construction.

Earlier this year, a grant was submitted with County support to the Recreation Trail Funding Program. This application is for Transportation Enhancement funds for the project. If the cities receive the first grant, this application will be removed from consideration.

The County has budgeted financial participation in the project of \$50,000 of which approximately \$47,000 is needed as a match. The County also approves the use of its right of way for the trail.

APPROVAL OF SUPPORT FOR USE OF SCOTT COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY FOR A BIKE TRAIL BETWEEN LONG GROVE AND ELDRIDGE AND SUPPORT OF GRANT APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF LONG GROVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. Long Grove and Eldridge will be developing a bike trail between the cities on Y64 and that the Scott County Board supports this bike trail and approves the use of Scott County right of way for this use.
- Section 2. That the Scott County Board supports the submittal of a grant by the City of Long Grove to the Transportation Enhancement Program for funds for the development and construction of the trail.
- Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
