Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

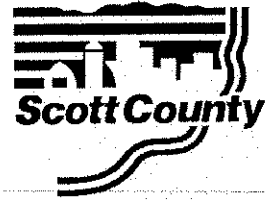
