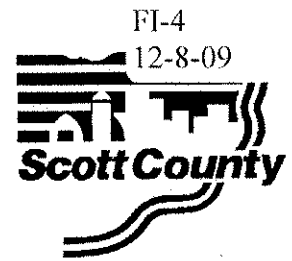

Subject: Approval of Purchase of Symantec Software Maintenance

Bids have been received for the purchase of software maintenance for Symantec Anti-Malware and desktop imaging software. The anti-malware software is loaded on all County desktop computers and servers and is used to prevent these computers from being a point of entry to the County network for computer viruses and other malicious software. The anti-malware software is memory resident and automatically checks files real-time for viruses with no client intervention. The desktop imaging software is used by I.T. to quickly deploy standardized software on County computers.
