Mr. Lowry is not eligible for a Military Tax Exemption because he did not serve during the eligible service times or for at least 18 months of active duty.

Mr. Shackleford is not eligible for a Military Tax Exemption because is "Character of Service" was "Uncharacterized" instead of "Honorable"
