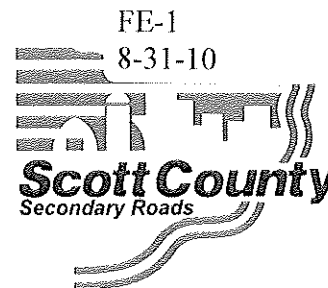

SUBJECT: Approval of two Projects: Fog Seal - Buttermilk Road and Chip Seal on Cody Road

DATE: August 31, 2010

We have been working with the City of Eldridge to place a single lift chip seal on Cody Road on the east side of Eldridge for about a year and a half. We do have money in our account - 464 Asphalt less than 8", which we will use to pay for this project. Although I prefer to plan this type of maintenance project for the next fiscal year so that it can be properly budgeted for, the City has decided to do it now. I have kept some money in this account specifically for this purpose. The project cost to us will be approximately \$42,152.

The city would also like to place a fog seal on Buttermilk Road which would cost us \$10,458. I concur that a fog seal is a good idea for this road. The payment for this would also come out of the 464 account. We have \$160,000 budgeted in the 464 for FY 11.

I recommend approval of a resolution authorizing the County Engineer to sign the proposals for these two projects.
