Subj: Juvenile Court Services Remodeling Project – Approval of Data Cabling Contract

Facility & Support Services recently solicited bids for data cabling for the new Juvenile Court Services space in a portion of the 1983 addition and 1898 old jail facility. These bids included all premise wiring from individual jacks in nearly every room in the remodeling project back to the newly established telecom / wiring room on the third floor of the existing Courthouse.

This new telecom room aligns with rooms created in previous projects on the second floor and lower level of the Courthouse, bringing the area up to current wiring standards and allowing for more flexibility for future wiring and IT needs in the building.

The request for bids was sent to all registered vendors in our purchasing system. From that request we received several bids.

Bids received are:
