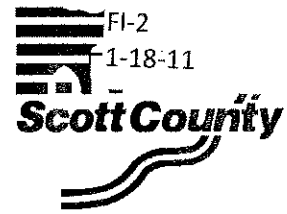

Bids have been received for the purchase of NetMotion remote connectivity software to be installed on Mobile Data Computers (MDC's) in the Sheriff's Office and Conservation Department's public safety vehicles.

This software will facilitate secure communications from Scott County public safety vehicles to Scott Emergency Communication Center (SECC) Computer Aided Dispatch/Records Management System (CAD/RMS).

Additional advantages include secure access to the Scott County network via VPN (Virtual Private Network) connectivity. County VPN connectivity provides access to any and all County applications including e-mail, MS Office, and etc.

Budget dollars are available in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget to fund the cost of this project.
