**APPROVING TEN SMART PLANNING PRINCIPLES AS AN ADDENDUM TO
CHAPTER TWO OF THE SCOTT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SCOTT COUNTY
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. The Scott County Planning and Zoning Commission held a Public Hearing on January 4, 2011 to consider the adoption of the ten Smart Planning Principles established under Iowa Code Chapter 18B Land Use.
- Section 2. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended that these ten Smart Planning Principles be added as an Addendum to Chapter Two of the adopted Scott County Comprehensive Plan.
- Section 3. As adopted and amended the Comprehensive Plan is intended to be used as a reference and a guide for the Board of Supervisors, other County Boards and Commissions and County Departments when making land use decisions for the unincorporated area of the County.
- Section 4. As stated when it was originally adopted in 2008, the Comprehensive Plan is not intended to be a static document but an active and dynamic Plan that will be regularly reviewed and updated.
- Section 5. The Board of Supervisors held its own public hearing on these ten Smart Planning Principles on January 20, 2011.
- Section 6. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and incorporates these ten Smart Planning Principles as an addendum to Chapter Two: Vision, Goals and Objectives of the Scott County Comprehensive Plan.
- Section 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
