The company, Bi-State Business Solutions and Postal Source have proposed services that would analyze our outgoing mail to look for possible efficiencies and more advantageous rates. An industry expert from the company would analyze our processes and suggest improvements we can make to save money and gain efficiency.Numerous local businesses have engaged Postal Source with high degrees of success. Typical experience is that the cost of the service is recouped in the first year from the postal cost savings.

The proposal from Postal Source is for \$13,495 and would be paid from our postage line item in the current fiscal year operating budget for Facility and Support Services. Postal Source also provides up to a 50% money-back guarantee should we fail to save the cost of the postal audit.
