Subj: Vehicle replacement bid for the Facility and Support Services Department

The Facility and Support Services Department is budgeted to replace one Class 4 one ton flatbed truck during the current fiscal year. This vehicle is used to haul equipment, parts and materials during the summer months and is our largest plow vehicle for snow removal in the winter. In addition, this vehicle carries our salt spreader in the winter. Attached is a spreadsheet that summarizes bids for this replacement.

I recommend that the Board approve the bids and award the purchase to Lindquist Ford in the total amount of \$24,763.00. This purchase is budgeted in FY12 in the amount of \$32,000. Also included in that budget amount is the purchase of the after-market flat bed and hydraulic pump to power the spreader. We are currently evaluating refurbishing and reusing the existing flatbed and pump from the current truck. If possible, that would reduce the cost to outfit the truck substantially. I will be available at the next Committee of the Whole meeting to answer any questions you or the Board may have.
