APPROVAL OF ROAD VACATION OF A PORTION OF SCOTT COUNTY ROAD COMMONLY KNOWN AS 300TH STREET NORTH OF LONG GROVE.

WHEREAS, The Scott County Board of Supervisors held a hearing on the proposed vacation of a portion of Scott County Secondary Road, described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is the Northeast corner of Section 14, Township 80, North of Range 3, East of the 5th P.M. thence South 40 feet on the East line of said Section 14, thence West 160 rods parallel with the North line of said Section 14, thence North 40 feet, thence East on the North line of said Section 14, 160 rods to the place of beginning.

Also, beginning at a point on the North line of Section 14, Township 80, North of Range 3 East of the 5th P.M. which is the intersection between the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 14, thence South 40 feet, thence West 80 rods parallel with the North line of said Section 14, thence North 40 feet, thence East 80 rods on the North line of said Section 14 to the place of beginning.

WHEREAS, An order pertaining to the matter of vacating a portion of 300th Street, has been issued by the Scott County Board of Supervisors. THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Scott County Board of Supervisors that the order is approved and by this reference incorporated herein and that the above described section of road be ordered vacated, subject to existing utility easements.
