Subj: State Energy Program Grant

As you know, Thom Hart approach the County about possibly submitting an application to the Iowa State Energy Program for some remaining stimulus funding for energy efficiency projects. The grant will fund up to 50% of efficiency projects, however there is a tight deadline for the use of the funds (end of February).

I have been working with representatives from the State Energy Program to discuss an application from Scott County. We have identified a number of lighting projects that would be eligible and approved for this grant program. Those projects primarily involve the replacement of our current flourescent lighting systems (34 watt, T-8 lamps) with a newer technology (28 watt, T-8 lamps).

These lighting retrofits were initially identified in our building energy audits and are included as projects that we have been discussing with Mid-American Energy as well. Below is a summary of the projects:

We propose to fund our portion of these projects in the current fiscal year using unspent dollars from other projects. The current updated proposed CIP for FY13 shows that

revision for FY12 and stays within budget. Collectively, these projects are projected to save over 290,000 kilowatt hours per year for a utility savings of \$17,533 at today's utility rates.

Because of the tight timeline, we have already solicited quotes for these projects to allow us to meet the timeline should the Board approve our application and participation in the grant program. I will have those bids at the Committee of the Whole for the Board to review as well. Should the Board elect to proceed we will have a resolution for the approval of the grant as well as one approving the bids for the various efficiency projects.
