RE: Addition of Grant Funded Position to Health Department Table of Organization

The Scott County Board of Health has been awarded the Community Transformation Grant from the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) for the project period of November 15, 2011 to September 29, 2016. The purpose of the contract is to create policy, environmental and systems changes at the community level that integrate public health, primary care, worksite and community initiatives to encourage healthier lifestyles, promote wellness, and prevent the health consequences of chronic disease that are often lifestyle related.

In order to support the work associated with the contract, the Scott County Health Department will receive \$65,500.00 per year, based upon the federal fiscal year. This contract is an implementation contract with the expectation that policy, environmental and system level changes will be implemented to support wellness in Scott County. After careful review of the expectations of the contract and the development of a work plan to address those expectations, the current workload of our existing staff, and the funding that has been allocated to support the efforts, we are requesting that a .6 FTE Community Health Consultant be added to the Health Department's table of organization in service area 20T-Community Relations, Information, and Planning. The responsibilities of this position would be directly related to the implementation of the Community Transformation Grant. We understand that this position would be dependent on continued funding from external sources and would not be a benefit-eligible position.

For budget planning purposes with the Iowa Department of Public Health, we anticipated that the earliest a staff person would start with the Department would be May 1, 2012. For five months of salary-May 1, 2012 to September 29, 2012, we anticipate the costs to be approximately \$13,300.00. Prior to that time, a team of employees from the Health Department will be managing the implementation efforts. The County will be reimbursed for their time. For a full year, the estimated costs associated with the position would be \$33,000.00.

APPROVING ORANIZATIONAL CHANGES IN THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT BY ADJUSTING THE FTE LEVEL OF THE COMMUNITY HEALTH CONSULTANTS
