Subject: Settlement of Teamster Contract

The Teamsters were coming off of a six year contract so ample time was spent modifying contract language to clarify issues that came up in the past five years. We made several non-economic changes such as addressing circumstances for performance improvement plans, changes to shift bid dates, and clarifications in the grievance process. We did make some changes to the payouts for compensatory time that will have some cost savings to the County. We were able to agree to the changes made to insurance in previous years with other unions, including the implementation of the healthy lifestyles program. We implemented a new Paid Time Off (PTO) program to replace vacation and sick leave that in other organizations has resulted in decreases of unscheduled leave and better employee attendance. The contract is a one year agreement with a 2% general wage increase and the employee will remain on 12 hour shifts.
