**ACKNOWLEDGING THE WITHDRAWAL OF A PETITION TO REZONE 318 ACRES
(MOL) IN SECTIONS 3 AND 10 OF BLUE GRASS TOWNSHIP FROM
AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION (A-P) TO HEAVY MANUFACTURING (M)**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. On June 29, 2012, Stanley Consultants, on behalf of its client, Iowa Fertilizer Company, submitted a petition to rezone 318 acres (more or less) located in Sections 3 and 10 of Blue Grass Township from Agricultural-Preservation (A-P) to Heavy Manufacturing (M).
- Section 2. On July 17, 2012, The Scott County Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on a 6-1 vote recommended denial of the rezoning petition based on its lack of compliance with a preponderance of the criteria of the revised land use policies and the goals and objectives of the 2008 adopted Scott County Comprehensive Plan.
- Section 3. On July 24, 2012, a report on the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation was forwarded to the Board of Supervisors by the Scott County Zoning Administrator.
- Section 4. On September 12, 2012, The Scott County Board of Supervisors has received a written request from Stanley Consultants and Iowa Fertilizer Company to withdraw this pending rezoning petition.
- Section 5. The Scott County Board of Supervisors hereby acknowledges the withdrawal of this rezoning petition and declares the rezoning process terminated.
- Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
