Subj: Radio replacements for the Jail

There is funding in the current fiscal year to replace the radios currently in use in the Jail. These radios currently operate on the same radio network as all other public safety agencies in Scott County. The Sheriff indicated that continued connectivity to those other agencies is very important to the Jail operation. The current radios are 15+ years old and will not be compatible with the local public safety radio network when it is upgraded to a P25 compliant system. That upgrade is expected in the next 18-24 months.

We solicited proposals to provide replacement radios that can communicate with the current system and that can upgrade to a P25 compliant 700/800 MHZ system in the future. We also required the vendor to perform testing of that compatibility and coverage within the jail facility prior to delivery and acceptance of the new radios.

The only proposal we received was from Racom Corporation. They propose to replace the existing radios (51 handheld and two base stations) including all accessories (batteries, chargers, belt clips, lapel mics, etc.) and test the building for coverage for a total cost of \$131,859.65. This project is budgeted in the Electronic Equipment portion of the Capital Plan in the amount of \$135,000.

I recommend that the Board approve the above purchase. I will attend the next Committee of the Whole meeting to discuss this purchase further and to answer any questions the Board may have.

Construction of new Facility Physical Plant building

As you are aware, Bracke, Hayes, Miller, Mahon Architects was selected to complete the design process for the Facility Physical Plant Building. This project includes demolition of the current residential building located at 503 Scott Street and construction of a new facility physical plant building located at that same address. This new building will replace the space currently located at the Horst Building as well as moving some functions from the small shop areas located at both the Courthouse and the Administrative Center. Bracke, Hayes, Miller, Mahon have completed plans and specifications for this project. The project requires a public hearing and the plans and specifications require Board approval. I am recommending approval by the Board and have published notice setting the public hearing for July 17, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. with approval of the plans and specifications also on the agenda that same night.

The demolition and construction estimate from the architect is \$420,000 and the project is budgeted in the FY15 Capital Plan. We are additionally expecting revenues from the sale of the current Horst facility once this new building is completed. The current bidding climate has seen project bids rising due to increased activity in the construction trades in our local market. We would expect the bids for this project to be at or slightly above the architects estimate.

I will be in attendance at the next Committee of the Whole to discuss this project and answer any questions you or the Board may have.
