#### Dear Board of Supervisors:

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 349 of the Code of Iowa, it is herewith respectfully requested that The North Scott Press, a newspaper of general circulation published at Eldridge, Scott County, Iowa, be designated an official newspaper in and for said Scott County for the year 2017.

We enclose a copy of our sworn statement of ownership, management and circulation, which was published per US Postal Service requirements on Oct. 12, 2016. Total distribution of the Press remains strong at 5,045 (which ranks second among 267 weeklies in Iowa!). This includes print circulation of 4,920, the large majority of which is in Scott County, and 125 who are not print subscribers but have paid to read *The NSP* online. This translates to nearly 15,000 readers each week.
