

The Scott County Secondary Roads Department requested proposals from qualified engineering firms to provide professional structural design services pertaining to the preliminary and final design of two bridge replacement projects that are in FY2019 of our construction program. Project No. L-319--73-82 is an existing 80' X 24' Steel I-Beam Bridge built in 1961 on 252<sup>nd</sup> Avenue over Lost Creek in Princeton Township. Project No. L-420--73-82 is an existing 67'-6 X 24' Steel I-Beam Bridge built in 1960 on 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue over Hickory Creek in Sheridan Township.

In December of 2018, we met with several consultants to review their qualifications pertaining to professional structural design services. The consultants provided information regarding their experience working with county engineering departments; familiarity with Iowa Department of Transportation design standards, specifications, and project development schedules; knowledge of local, state and federal regulations; and provided example plan sets of similar projects.

The consultants were evaluated on their experience and expertise with similar projects, the experience of their proposed project team and key members, the overall quality of their sample deliverable documents, their ability to perform work within the given time-frame, and fees.

We are recommending that IIW, P.C. be selected to perform the professional structural design services for preliminary and final design of bridge replacement project L-319--73-82 and L-420--73-82. The Contract estimate is \$28,000 for preliminary and final design not including geotechnical services. This firm has performed bridge and culvert design work utilizing Iowa Department of Transportation standards and specifications for many of the counties and municipalities in Eastern Iowa and is a core component of IIW's services. IIW was founded in 1982, is employee-owned since 1999, and is well known and respected as a bridge design consultant. We are recommending that Scott County enter into agreement with, IIW, P.C.

#### 1. Exclusive and Express Warranty Coverage and Coverage Limitations:

1.1 Limited Emissions Components for GM 3.0L/4.3L, Nissan K25, PSI 2.4L/3.0L/4.3L, Cummins (All Platforms), Curtis AC Powerplants - 3 years or 2500 hours. Related components include any engine parts related to the following systems: Air-induction system. Fuel System. Ignition System. Exhaust Gas Recirculation Systems. Catalyst. Crankcase Ventilation Valves. Sensors. Electronic Control Units. Malfunction Indicator Light. Fuel Tank. Fuel Cap. Fuel Line. Fuel Line Fittings and Clamps. Pressure Relief Valves. Control Valves. Components that are not directly involved with fuel control or the emission control system — as well as the accessories manufactured or supplied/attached by IMPCO Technologies (and sold to Octane Forklifts for installation in IMPCO certified engines) - will be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 1 year or 2000 hours, whichever occurs first. Replacement parts may be new, remanufactured, reconditioned, or repaired depending on the specific component and particular circumstances involved.

All components used to meet IMPCO Technologies Inc. standards are warranted for the unexpired portion of the warranty period. The warranty period begins on the date the Forklift is delivered to the Buyer. However, if the Forklift is first placed in service as a demonstrator, prior to sale, the warranty period begins on the date that the Forklift was first placed into service, presale, as a demonstrator. The warranty covers ONLY malfunctions resulting from defects in material or workmanship.

- 1.3 Cummins Diesel Base Engine Warranty- 2 years or 2000 hours. Applicable to: Base Engine. \*Not applicable to the A Series Engine.
- 1.4 Cummins Diesel Extended Major Component Warranty- 3 years or 10,000 hours. Applicable to: \*Registered Parts Only Cylinder Block, Camshaft, Crankshaft, Connecting Rod. Coverage begins on the expiration of the Base Engine Warranty and ends at the time or hour limitation listed above, whichever comes first, after the warranty start date.
- 1.5 Octane Chassis /Non Emissions Related Warranty- 1 year or 2000 hours. This includes parts that are not related to emissions control.
- 1.6 Octane Limited Warranty- 6 months or 1000 hours. For FY19 vehicle buy plan, it was identified that three vehicles for the Sheriff's Office would be used vehicles. In previous attempts to solicit bids for used cars, no bids were submitted on Public Purchasing website. In searching for candidates, Fleet Services used the criteria of less than three years old, still some manufacturer warranty left, mileage of less than 25,000 and no accident damage.

After a few months of searching the local Quad City used car inventory, prices started to drop at the first of the year. Fleet Services was able to find 3 strong candidates. A Scott County Purchase Card was used to put and \$500 down payment to hold the vehicles pending approval of purchases. Two of the vehicles were below the threshold of the \$15,000.00 Board of Supervisor's approval requirement. All candidates were given approval from the Sheriff's Office as an acceptable replacement.

Replacement eligibility was analyzed using the American Public Work Association (APWA) Fleet Replacement Guideline. The point's ranges are:

Under 18 points Condition I Excellent 18 to 22 points Condition II Good

23 to 27 points Condition III Qualifies for replacement 28 points and above Condition IV Needs immediate consideration





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

Re: First Reading of an ordinance to rezone a 33-acre tract, more or less, from "Agricultural-General (A-G)" to "Single-Family Residential (R-1)" located in the vicinity of 15378 270th Street and legally described as the SE¼ of the SW¼ less the west seven (7) acres in Section 27 of Winfield Township.

The Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of the rezoning in accordance with staff's recommendation. The Commission determined that the request met a preponderance of the criteria of the land use policies. The area is currently zoned A-G which is designated as a "holding zone" until compatible development is proposed, it is shown on the Future Land Use Map as appropriate for residential development, it has soils with marginal crop productivity, it is near employment and commercial centers, it has access to a paved road and it is adjacent to other residential development. The property also is not directly adjacent to Long Grove corporate boundary and therefore could not be annexed.

The Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the application on January 10<sup>th</sup>. Many of the concerns raised by neighboring property owners at that hearing were related to issues that would be addressed during the review of any future subdivision of the property. Other concerns appeared to be related to private disputes among the neighbors and objections to the existing condition of the applicant's property.

**PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:** The Planning Commission recommends approval of the request to rezone this property from Agricultural-General (A-G) to Single-Family Residential (R-1) based on its compliance with a preponderance of the criteria of the Revised Land-Use Policies.

As you are aware, a committee was established to look at implementing a Crisis Communications Plan, a Crisis Management Plan and a Continuity of Operations Plan / Continuity of Government (COOP/COG). As we met and discussed this task, it quickly became apparent that the scope was simply too much for one group to keep moving. As a result of this realization, we broke the tasks down into three smaller subgroups and identified a staff member(s) to take the lead for each task.

The Crisis Communications Plan sub group, which includes representatives from the Health Department, Sheriff's Office, Human Resources, Facility & Support Services and IT, evaluated two separate products to implement the first phase of the Crisis Communications Plan.

Quotes were received from Alertus and Singlewire. Both allow for features which include desktop notifications, notifications across CISCO phones on the County network, and include the additional functionality of a mobile app.

The Alertus product was the preference of the group due to the additional features that can be deployed in future phases, the ease of use and the lower price point. Additionally, the reference agency for this product was very pleased with the product, the ease of use, and the technical support that Alertus provides.

The Alertus product quote is \$33,690.00, which includes a three year maintenance contract at a 5% discount for the three year time frame. The Singlewire quote is \$44,471.50. This purchase is funded in the Capital budget in the amount of \$40,000.

I recommend the Board approve the quote from Alertus. I will be at the next Committee of the Whole meeting to answer any questions.

An ad-hoc committee comprised of Rita Vargas, Sherlyn Huber, Sara Skelton, Matt Hirst, John Heim, and Stephanie Macuga researched options for preservation of records stored in the Recorder's Office on film. We recommend the selection of U.S. Imaging to scan and index these types of records currently stored in the Recorder's Office. We anticipate scanning records and conversion from analog to digital media for such records from approximately April, 1971 to December, 1988. The recommendation is based on results of an RFP issued by the committee in the fourth quarter of 2018.

A cost comparison for the scanning of these records and indexing from the top three respondents to the RFP is as follows:

We believe it important to document the selection process undertaken to convey the quantity and quality of work conducted to identify a technology partner to assist the County with this work. The Committee investigated what other governments in Iowa and Illinois have done to address the retention of records stored on film and found that proactive organizations are converting such records to digital records. Additionally, a Request for Proposal (RFP), RFP #19406 titled, "Digital Conversion and Indexing Services" was issued in October of 2018. Fourteen (14) responses were received and the top three (3) were interviewed.

US Imaging emerged as the clear choice for the Scott County Recorder's Office for this project through this process.

At this time, we are requesting Board approval to enter into contract negotiations with US Imaging for scanning and indexing services. The final negotiated contract will be presented to the Board for approval at a future date. Budget dollars are available from the County CIP program to pay for this project over the next two (2) fiscal years.

**WHEREAS**, the King Day of Service is the only federal holiday commemorated as a national day of service, and offers an opportunity for Americans to give back to their communities on the holiday and make an ongoing commitment to service throughout the year; and

**WHEREAS,** King Day of Service projects are being organized by a wide range of nonprofit and community organizations, educational institutions, public agencies, private businesses, and other organizations across the nation; and

WHEREAS, each of us can and must contribute to making our communities better with increased opportunity for all our citizens, and

WHEREAS, citizens of Scott County have the opportunity to participate in events throughout our county on the King Day of Service, January 21, 2019, as well as create and implement community service projects where they identify the need.

#### **BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim the Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday as a Day of Service in Scott County and calls upon the people of Scott County to pay tribute to the life and works of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. through participation in community service projects on Martin Luther King Day and throughout the year.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
