Dear Board of Supervisors:

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 349 of the Code of Iowa, it is herewith respectfully requested that The North Scott Press, a newspaper of general circulation published at Eldridge, Scott County, Iowa, be designated an official newspaper in and for said Scott County for the year 2020.

Total print distribution of the Press is strong at 4,908 (second among 267 weeklies in Iowa!). The large majority of print subscribers are in Scott County. An additional 145 who are not print subscribers pay to read *The NSP* online. Combined readership at 2.74 readers per copy translates to nearly 14,000 each week. Further, research by Newton Marketing and Research shows that 91 percent of Iowans find their local newspaper trustworthy when publishing public notices, and 85 percent of Iowans believe state and local government should be required to publish public notices in newspapers.

As a value-added service at no cost to you, your notices are uplinked to the Iowa Newspaper Association public notice web site at www.Iowanotices.org. There, the public enjoys free, 24-hour access to more than 100,000 legal notices from throughout Iowa each year.

The procedures which the Board shall follow in the event of a contest for official newspapers are stipulated in Sections 349.6 through 349.14 of the Code of Iowa. If necessary, we will provide a list of the names of bona fide paid subscribers for your inspection.

APPROVING DESIGNATION OF THE NORTH SCOTT PRESS AND THE QUAD CITY TIMES AS SCOTT COUNTY OFFICIAL NEWSPAPERS

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. That the North Scott Press, and the Quad City Times, are hereby appointed as Scott County Official newspapers for a one year period ending on December 31, 2020 subject to meeting all requirements as stated in the Iowa Code.
- Section 2. That the newspapers do not charge more than what is set by the Iowa Department of Administrative Services in accordance with Section 618.11 of the Code of Iowa.
- Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
