On May 16, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved the submission of a grant application to the Iowa Living Roadway Trust Fund for the purchase of a truck bed style injection type roadside sprayer. The equipment will allow for greater accuracy, more efficient spraying and GPS speed and guidance control. The Scott County Secondary Roads Department was awarded the grant for 80% of a roadside sprayer cost with a maximum eligible reimbursement of \$15,000.

Bids were solicited using the Public Purchase portal on our Scott County website. The following bids were received:

Spray-Land USA, Marion, IA:	\$19,575.00
MTI Distributing, Inc., Grimes, IA:	\$21,932.76

I recommend purchasing the roadside sprayer from Spray-Land USA for a cost of \$19,575. We will be reimbursed from the Iowa Living Roadway Trust Fund grant for \$15,000. The remaining \$4,575 is in our FY2020 Road Clearing budget.

Please find attached the resolution to approve the FY21 Maximum Proposed Tax Levy. The public hearing is to be held on Thursday, February 20, 2020 and advanced notice of the hearing was published Wednesday February 5, 2020 in the two official County newspapers and was posted on the county website according to state law.

The maximum tax levy hearing is in accordance with SF 634 (2019 legislative session). Following the public hearing SF 634 requires a resolution be adopted approving the maximum tax dollars (property tax plus utility replacement tax requests) that may be assessed during the year. Following the resolution adopting the maximum tax levy, the board may set the time, date and place for the hearing on the regular county budget. This is tentatively scheduled for March 19, 2020. The budget is required to be adopted by March 31, 2020. A resolution setting the budget hearing is also attached as a separate action.

The proposed maximum tax levy dollars is \$51,019,414 within the General Fund and \$3,333,416 within the rural services fund. The County may not exceed the approved amount of the maximum tax levy or the published budget.
