Scott County Call for Action

Reduce Covid-19 Spread Recommendations

July 23, 2020

WHEREAS, The World Health Organization has declared the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (Covid19) a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, The President of the United States and Governor of Iowa have declared National and State Emergency Proclamations; and

WHEREAS, The impact of the pandemic continues to meet the parameters of a civil emergency; and

WHEREAS, Covid-19 spreads mainly from person to person through respiratory droplets when infected people cough, sneeze, or talk; and

WHEREAS, The number of persons testing positive test for Covid-19 have increased; and

WHEREAS, Reducing the spread of Covid-19 will allow the economic community to remain open to the public during the pandemic; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors, Scott County Board of Health, and the Scott County Health Department hereby recommends:

- A. If you are sick, stay home.
- B. Wash hands often with both soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- C. Practice social distancing between yourself and other people (at least 6 feet).
- D. Cover your mouth and nose with a face covering/shield whenever social distancing is not practical and/or other means to provide separation are not present.
- E. Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue away.
- F. Clean and disinfect touched surfaces and objects frequently.

Section 2. These recommendations shall take effect immediately.
