BE IT RESOLVED BY the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Canvassers hereby ORDERS that a recount of the votes cast in the 2020 election for United States Representative District Two be recounted pursuant to the requirements of Iowa Code Section 50.48.
