

NAHT Priorities

- I. The NAHT asks the Legislature to adopt a Safe Harbor Law to eliminate charging minors or commercially sex exploited individuals with prostitution and minor labor trafficking victims with crimes committed during the course of their exploitation.

- II. The NAHT asks the Legislature to pass a law for the expungement of crimes committed by human trafficking survivors which occurred while being trafficked.

- III. The NAHT asks the Legislature to request schools to provide employees, parents and guardians training, support, awareness and prevention of child sexual harassment exploitation, or abuse. PreK – 12 age appropriate teaching to recognize child abuse and human trafficking with instruction to tell a trusted adult is needed.

- IV. The NAHT asks that either the Iowa Supreme Court adopt rules or that the Iowa Legislature enact legislation to include extending rape shield protection to human trafficking victims in the Rape Shield Law.

- V. The NAHT requests that the Legislature pass legislation for uniform Local Law Enforcement Authority regarding Massage Business that would expand rather than limit local control.
