Harrisburg, Pennsylvania to establish the Scott County "Alternative to Detention" juvenile justice pilot program as an option for pre-trial or pre-sentencing judicial disposition subject to approval by Juvenile Court authorities within the Iowa District Court for Scott County. All costs of the one-year, community-based pilot program, including management, staffing, operations and facility fees, will be borne entirely by the Youth Advocate Program up to a maximum of \$500,000. The long-term goal of the Scott County "Alternative to Detention" program is to provide intensive, community-based, family-focused services through the evidence-based "YAPWrap" model to approximately 40-50 young people, who would otherwise be incarcerated in the Scott County Detention Center. These services will be delivered in partnership with the Davenport-based Lincoln Resource Center. Near the conclusion of the twelve-month pilot program, an independent, community-based committee shall evaluate outcomes to date and recommend to the Board of Supervisors continuation of the program at County expense or termination.
