Subject: Emergency Communication Software License and Support

Scott County Information Technology has received a quote for Emergency Communication software license and support from Alertus.

The quotation from Alertus will provide Scott County three (3) years licensing and access to support. The three (3) year contract provides seven (7) percent savings over a one year contract.

In 2019 the County purchased the staff alert system called Alertus. Alertus is used to alert County staff of a dire circumstance, such as an active shooter or other emergencies. All county employees have access to use Alertus to send a notification to alert others to an active shooter on one of Scott County's campuses. Emergency notifications sent out via Alertus are sent to all desktop computers/tablets, desktop phones, and personal mobile phones that have the Alertus app downloaded.

It is recommended that the Board authorize the IT Director to sign the quote in the amount of \$25,372. Monies are available in the IT department budget to pay for this service.
