



Proclamation

RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF MAY AS MILITARY APPRECIATION MONTH

WHEREAS, our men and women in uniform serving all over the world remind us of the sacrifices necessary to maintain freedom. The strong contributions made by Scott County members of the United States Armed Forces, and the family members who support them, have preserved our liberties; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the United States Congress passed a resolution proclaiming May as National Military Appreciation Month, calling on all Americans to remember those who gave their lives in defense of freedom and to honor the men and women of all Armed services who have served, or are now serving our country; and

WHEREAS, the liberties we enjoy as citizens of the United States are won and preserved at great cost, and every American owes our men and women in uniform a lasting debt of gratitude for their heroism; and

WHEREAS, May 2022 will serve as the time of reflection on the courageous members of the United States military and provide a special occasion for all citizens to honor these individuals in our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim May 2022 as Military Appreciation Month;
- Section 2. That the Board of Supervisors encourages fellow citizens to recognize and respect the invaluable service members of the United States Armed Forces have provided to Scott County, the State of Iowa, and to our nation.
- Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
