APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A JOINT APPLICATION WITH DAKOTA, MINNESOTA & EASTERN RAILROAD COMPANY (DBA CANADIAN PACIFIC) FOR HIGHWAY-RAILROAD SAFETY PROGRAM FUNDING FOR TRAIN WARNING DEVICE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT THE RAILROAD CROSSING ON 210TH STREET BETWEEN BRADY STREET AND HIGHWAY 61

BE IT RESOLVED by the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- Section 1. Canadian Pacific and Scott County are seeking federal funding to upgrade the train warning safety devices at the railroad crossing on 210th Street between Brady Street and Highway 61. The federal funding is for 90% of the total project cost of the improvements.
- Section 2. That the County Engineer be authorized to sign the joint application with Canadian Pacific for Highway-Railroad Safety Program federal funding managed by the Iowa Department of Transportation on behalf of the Board.

- Section 3. That Scott County will contribute funding of 5% of the total project cost of the improvements.
- Section 4. That the application for funding and commitment of 5% of the total project cost will be valid for FY2024 through FY2029.
- Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
