Phone lines will be placed on mute during the meeting. Participants may unmute their line using the mute icon or \*6 on their phone after being recognized by the Chair.

### Telephone / Cell Phones Connections:

Telephones lines will be placed on mute during the meeting. Participants may "raise their hand" by using \*3 to gain attention of the host.



When called upon for comments by the Board,


1. The host will then unmute the participant's line at the appropriate time.
2. A user must have his or her own device unmuted.
3. The user may then unmute his or her conference line by keying \* 6
4. After conversation, please lower your hand. (\*3 again)


### Computer / Application Connections:

If connected via web application or computer, the user should look for the **Raise Hand**  raise hand symbol and click to appear raised so the host may acknowledge you.

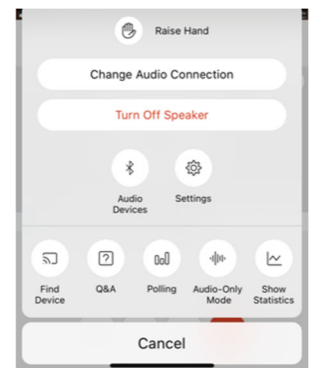
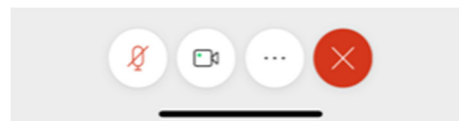
1. The host will then unmute the participant's line at the appropriate time.
2. A user must have his or her own device unmuted.
3. The user may then unmute his or her conference line by clicking the microphone symbol.
4. After conversation, please lower your hand. (\*3 again)

You can mute yourself so that everyone can concentrate on what's being discussed. While you're on a call or in a meeting, select  at the bottom of the meeting window. You'll know it's working when the button turns red .

If you want to unmute yourself, select . Others can hear you when the button turns gray.

When you're muted and move away from the call controls, the mute button moves to the center of your screen and fades in color  to indicate that you're still muted.

## RESOLUTION

### SCOTT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

September 20, 2022

### Recognizing September as National Voter Registration Month

WHEREAS, registering to vote empowers eligible citizens to exercise their right to vote on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, Iowa consistently ranks among the top 10 states in the nation for voter registration and voter participation, with more than two-million residents currently registered to vote; and

WHEREAS, 17-year-olds are now eligible to register to vote in Iowa; and

WHEREAS, Iowa's voter registration process is easier and more convenient than ever before, with online voter registration, Election Day registration, and applications available through government agencies across the state; and

WHEREAS, the State of Iowa's online voter registration system enables citizens to register to vote and update their registration status quickly and easily, any time of day; and

WHEREAS, we encourage all interested citizens and all appropriate media outlets and civic organizations to participate in this non-partisan voter registration awareness campaign to encourage the maximum participation of qualified voters in Iowa.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Scott County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim the month of September 2022 to be National Voter Registration Month and Tuesday, September 20, 2022 as National Voter Registration Day.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
