










CROW CREEK WMA EMERGENCY BOAT RAMP - CONCEPT

Snapshot Water Quality Monitoring

Snapshot Background



- 62 Snapshot sites throughout Scott County
- PSCW sampling since October 2000, most sites started in 2002
- Analyze for nitrate, nitrite, ammonia, phosphorus, chloride, pH, dissolved oxygen, air/water temp, transparency.
- Additional lab analysis on nitrate, nitrite and phosphorus, herbicides, pesticides and fecal DNA.
- Over 30,000 individual records
