SCOTT COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 23
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP BY REZONING APPROXIMATELY 55.7 ACRES IN SECTION 6, PRINCETON TOWNSHIP FROM AGRICULTURAL-PRESERVATION (A-P) TO CONSERVATION-RECREATION (C-R), ALL WITHIN UNINCORPORATED SCOTT COUNTY.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SCOTT COUNTY IOWA:
<b>Section 1.</b> In accordance with Section 6-31 <u>Scott County Code</u> , the following described unit of real estate is hereby rezoned from Agricultural-Preservation (A-P) to Conservation-Recreation (C-R) to-wit:
The NW1/4SW1/4 of Section 6 in Township 79 North, Range 5 East of the 5 <sup>th</sup> P.M. (Princeton Township) AND the SW1/4SW1/4 of Section 6 in Township 79 North, Range 5 East of the 5 <sup>th</sup> P.M. (Princeton Township) excluding the South 776.07 feet of the SW1/4SW1/4 of Section 6 in Township 79 North, Range 5 East of the 5 <sup>th</sup> P.M. (Princeton Township)
<b>Section 2.</b> This ordinance changing the above described land to Conservation-Recreation (C-R) is approved as recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission.
Section 3. The County Auditor is directed to record this ordinance in the County Recorder's Office.
<b>Section 4.</b> Severability Clause. If any of the provisions of this Ordinance are for any reason illegal or void then the lawful provisions of the Ordinance, which are separate from said unlawful provisions shall be and remain in full force and effect, the same as if the Ordinance contained no illegal or void provisions.
<b>Section 5.</b> Repealer. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.
<b>Section 6.</b> Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its final passage and publication as by law provided.
