

by the Secretary, and in no case shall there be allowed any improvements or interments upon lots until the Secretary has been paid and issued a receipt for the same.

No debts shall be contracted and no additions or improvements made to or on this cemetery except by consent of the Association at its annual meeting or at a meeting called expressly for that purpose. All lots in this Cemetery shall under no circumstances be used for any other purpose than the burial of dead human beings and no person shall be interred therein who has committed suicide, died in prison or been executed for crime except by permission of the directors and there shall be no assignment or sale of lots or parts of lots by the owner except the directors are notified and gave their consent.

The consent of the Directors must be obtained to disinter any one buried here, to build stone wall or fence around lots, to build vaults above ground, to remove stones or monuments, to remove ornamental trees, to bury more than one person in the same grave, to change inscriptions upon stones or monuments or to inter a person in the night.

No corpse shall be disinterred for burial in another lot in this Cemetery or removal to another cemetery except upon a certificate of permission from the state board of health approved by the local board of health and consent of the directors of this Association. The disinterment shall be conducted by no one except a licensed undertaker.

The Directors of this Association reserve to themselves the right to remove any trees or shrubs that by means of

Important

It is hereby urged that the one whose duty it is to keep this record shall faithfully do so according to the plans here laid down. If kept in years to come the record will be very valuable. The figures in the upper left hand corner of each lot in the plat in this book gives the page in this book of the record of the respective lot. The small "s." in the lower right hand corner of each lot indicates that the lot is sold. The same is true in the large plats. The manner of keeping the record of each separate lot is fully indicated on page eleven, of this book. The scale of each lot is one fourth, $\frac{1}{4}$, of one $\frac{1}{2}$, which equals one foot. Hence each lot can be marked off with a pocket rule. A record thus kept may save much trouble and dispute and even litigation in the future.
