

LIIN GROVE CEMETERY

On 7 June 1859 at 10:40 a.m., land was deeded to the Trustees of Wesley Chapel M. E. Church by Robert Barnes & wife (the north 1/2 of the cemetery in Section 2, Township 79 North, Range 2 East., Hickory Grove Township) and by Alexander Wells & Juliann S. Wells (the south 1/2 of the cemetery in Section 11, Township 79 North, Range 2 East., Hickory Grove Township). The original records are in the possession of James Orville Grell of Maysville, Iowa.

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RULES

The price of lots is\$5.00.
The price of half lots\$2.50.

All money obtained from the sale of lots to be expressly appropriated to the fencing and improving the grave yard.

All lots east of Nos. 8, are free. Those burying on free lots are required to bury one end of any lot they may choose, or immediately adjoining some other grave.

A record of all who are buried in this grave yard is to be carefully made in this book.
